**The Abbey:** A Cistercian house founded in 1179 as a daughter house of Strata Florida. It was one of only a handful of Cistercian monasteries in the country. The remains of that abbey are incorporated into the present buildings housing the Sisters of Saint Joseph. The fine barn is one of the finest medieval remnants. In the grounds just to the west is the church, formerly a chapel associated with the abbey. There is also a walled garden, complete with a labyrinth.

**The Charity:** The plight of the dislodged Christians and other minority groups in Northern Iraq has reached genocide thresholds and touched many hearts. It was recently broadcasted on BBC2 (Killing The Christians) and clearly demonstrated the sufferings and hardships. Despite these adversities these exiled communities have adhered to their religions and in that process lost all possessions. ICIN which was founded in 2007 is providing **DIRECT** financial, medical and shelter support to these groups through a liaison with all the churches in the "safe haven" zones.
