Related to establishment of dependent states (shaykhdoms, kingdoms etc) the rise of abundant oil money. Traditional industries die; market selected agriculture took over. Migration of peoples from oil poor to oil rich. From these changes the Ba'ath, Free Officers, etc Arab Nationalists all arose. Iraq revolutions of 1920 and 1958, Syrian 1925-7 and 1963, Palestinian of 1936-9, Algerian 1954-62, guerilla risings of 1965-74 Dhofar, Libyan of 1969, 1961-7 civil wars in N Yemen, 1970 Jordan, 75-6 in Lebanon. Reflect underlying structural discordances, conflict between ethnic, religious groups, economic classes that suffered and those that benefitted.  
Iraq much of the backing of the Communists came from the manual textile industry in Baghdad Babash Shaykh, and from Amarah, intensification of the Shakhys hold on the land and the big land owners using irrigation pumps on the Tigris in Kut and Baghdad. Significantly the revolution may be considered a rural one.  
Note the vast increase in state employees and the state bureaucracy  
Note the rise in urbanisation he cites in 1980 Iraq's population was as much as 72%  
Note the role of the increase in imports in all the Arab countries  
All three revolutions initially sought to reduce their countries subordination to the Western economy and the international division of labour.
